

New Die Marriage 1844

WB-16, Repunched 18 (Discovery Coin)

Obverse 4



- Date slants up to right (photo). The 18(44) is repunched obliquely south (photo below). The initial punching of the date appears to be level and was then repositioned as slanted up to the right for the final punching.



Reverse A



- Small lump on the outside upper edge of the (AMER)C(A) (photo).



- Thick arcing line in the dentils above UNIT(ED) (photo)
- Unclashed and uncracked die

This is the first use of this obverse die and first use of this reverse die.

This die marriage was discovered by Ray Tetreault.
