Obverse 6



- Date very weak in the only example seen (photo)
- Many details weak from die polishing
- Die diagnostics seen in the previous use of this die (WB-18) are now not visible.

Reverse N



- Large O mintmark (photo)
- Die cracks thru entire legend and denomination with a cud forming along top of letters (UNI)TED. Another from the upper left serif of the D(OL) thru the mintmark to the olive stem.

This is the third use of this obverse die and first use of this reverse die.
Fred Clowe discovered this die marriage.
