- Date far left and high (photo) with 18(48) repunched south (photo below)



Reverse F

- The die lines seen between the dentils and the letters (STA)TES seen on the previous uses of this die (WB-8, 9, and 10) are not now visible.
- The double lump defect seen on the (AMERIC)A on the previous uses of this die (WB-8, 9, 10, and 12) is not now visible.
- Die cracks in the denomination and legend (see enhanced die crack diagram on next page) and images below.



- Clash in shield's lower right

This is the second use of this obverse die and fifth use of this reverse die.
