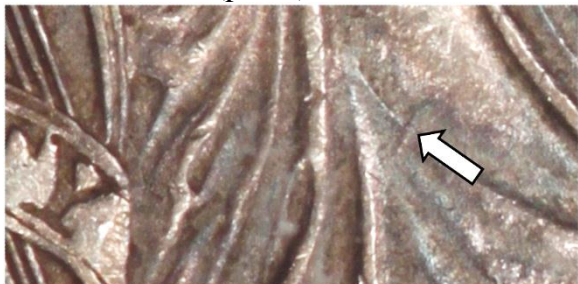


1866-S With Motto WB-11, New Die Marriage (B. Stallard)

Obverse 2



- Centered date (photo)



- Diagonal die line in Liberty's gown near Liberty's left calf (photo)
- Weak rock support below Liberty's toes
- Clash in drapery below Liberty's elbow
- This is an EDS of this obverse without the die cracks seen on later use of this die.

Reverse G



- Very small S mintmark high under the feather tip (photo)



- Three lumps in/near scroll: two near the T(RUST) and one in the field below the (T)R(UST) (photo)

This is an EDS and the first use of this obverse die and only use of this reverse die.
The imaged coin is the discovery piece.
