

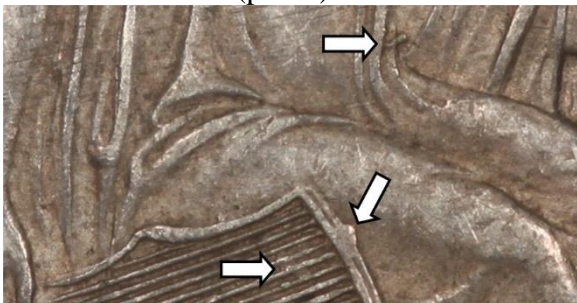
## New Die Marriage 1876-CC

### WB-42, Medium CC (Discovery Coin)

#### Obverse 29



- Centered date (photo)



- Large lump on Liberty's stomach, along the upper right edge of the shield, and in the upper horizontal shield lines (photo)

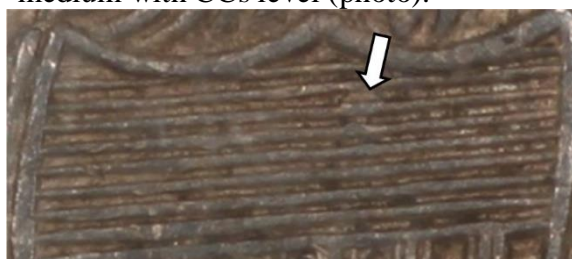


- Scattered lumps on Liberty's neck and head (photo); others on Liberty's chest and torso area

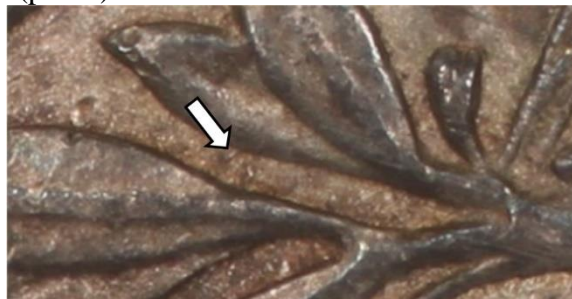
#### Reverse G



- Medium CC with wide spacing, placed medium with CCs level (photo).



- Large lump in the upper horizontal shield lines (photo)



- Small lumps in the recessed area between olive leaves #3 and #4
- Weak upper scroll edge above (TR)UST
- Weak die crack thru legend and denomination (see next page)
- Weak tail feathers below shield

This is the first use of this obverse die and third use of this reverse die.

This die marriage was discovered by Mike Clark of Bozarth Coins.
