

New Die Marriage 1844-O

WB-23, Large O, Repunched Second 4 (Discovery Coin)

Obverse 6



- Date centered with the second 4 repunched south (photo)



- Die crack from Liberty's big toe to the dentil below star 13 (photo); another thru stars 3-7, Liberty's head and star 8 (photo)



- All die states: rim cud at K-7 (photo)

Reverse K



- Large O mintmark with a weak vertical die crack thru the mintmark (photo).
- Many die cracks – see enhanced die crack diagram on the following page.



- Prominent die crack between (HAL)F D(OL) (photo)



- Parallel die lines thru STATES OF (photo)

This is the third use of this obverse die and first use of this reverse die.

This die marriage was discovered by David Kahn.
