

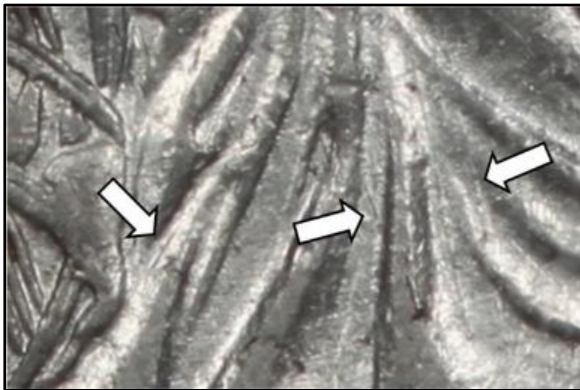
New Die Marriage 1853-O

WB-22, Arrows and Rays (Discovery Coin)

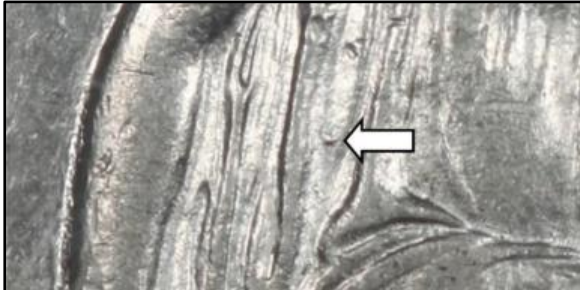
Obverse 16



- Centered date (photo). Note roughness/rust/unfinished areas around the date.



- Vertical die lines in Liberty's gown to the right of the shield (photo)

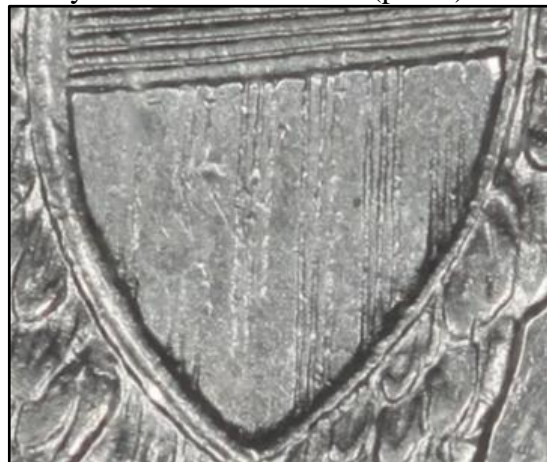


- Small lump in Liberty's gown to the right of the left arm (photo)
- Clash marks in Liberty's lap

Reverse J



- Large O mintmark, positioned high, and with no rays inside the mintmark (photo).



- Very weak vertical shield lines (photo)



- Lump on top upper right of (H)A (photo)

This is the first use of this obverse die and third use of this reverse die.
