

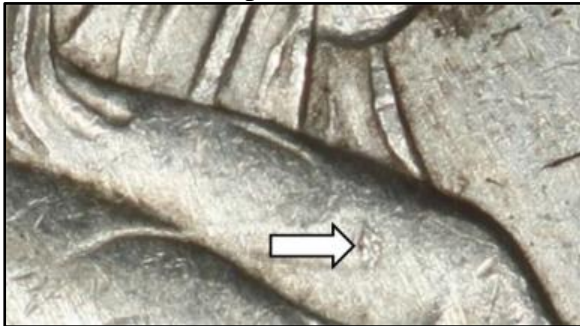
New Die Marriage 1869-S

WB-4, Very Small S (Discovery Coin)

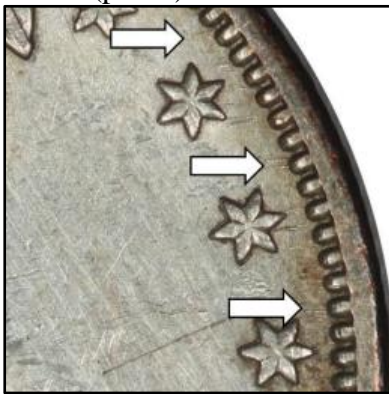
Obverse 1



- Centered date (photo)



- Lump on top of Liberty's leg above the right knee (photo)



- Many radial die lines from K-1 to K-6 including below the right side of the date (photo)

Reverse C



- Very small S mintmark positioned slightly left of the croch (photo).



- Reverse die cracks notably from the rim to the upper right serif of the (U)N diagonally through I to the base of TED (photo). See enhanced die crack diagram on the next page.

This is the first use of this obverse die and second use of this reverse die.

Dick Osburn discovered this new die marriage with an AU55 raw coin.
