WB-5, Medium-small S (Discovery Coin)

Obverse 1



- Date right (photo)



- Large lump in Liberty's lap to the left of the pole base; another on Liberty's left leg and another in the gown folds to the left of the elbow (photo)

Reverse B



- Medium-small S mintmark low and above the left edge of the D(OL) (photo). This mintmark is almost blob-like; the upper loop is completely filled in and the lower loop is nearly closed.



- Heavy horizontal die line to the right of the lower shield tip (photo)

This is the second use of this obverse die and second use of this reverse die.

This die marriage was discovered by Dick Osburn.
