WB-45, Very small S (Discovery Coin)

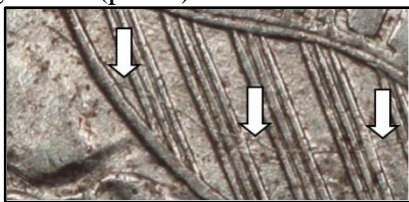
Obverse 1



- Date right with small lumps in the rock support above the date (photos above and below)



- Spike into rock support from Liberty's right foot (photo)



- Wavy die line thru shield (photo)
- Other scattered lines and lumps on Liberty

Reverse FF

Type I reverse



- Very small S mintmark placed slightly left of the crotch formed by the olive stem and the feather tip (photo).



- Small lump in the eagle's feathers below A-3 (photo)
- Weak scroll above (TR)UST

This is the second (?) use of this obverse die and first use of this reverse die.

This die marriage was discovered by Bob Muzzi.
