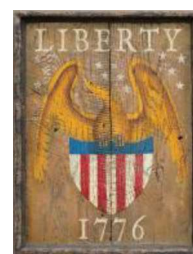
Gosh, E-Gobrecht is about to embark on its 23rd year of publication having completed its 22nd year Anniversary and 250+ issues. That's a long time!
