## A Coin World Survey of Liberty Seated Dimes, 1987 to 1992

Over a period of five and a half years I made a list of all the Liberty Seated dimes listed for sale in Coin World ads to document the relative availability of the many dates in this series of United States coins. During the period from January 1987 to August 1992, I recorded the contents of 1457 ads from 159 dealers which contained offerings of Liberty Seated dimes. Every ad was compared to previous ads from the same dealer and all duplicate listings were eliminated. It is recognized that this procedure might eliminate some duplicates that a dealer would have in stock, but I felt that this recording method would not significantly alter the results.

The major advantage of this recording technique is that it provides a more accurate estimate of the actual number of coins available. The results of my Coin World survey are given in Table I . The frequency of availability is given for each date in six circulated grades, in four mint state grades, and in proof condition. Surprisingly, this study showed that only 9745 coins were offered for sale during the entire five and a half year period. Previous Coin World surveys have been conducted on the dime series but availability is known to change with time as some issues become more popular or price adjustments make some issues more attractive for sale or purchase. This survey thus represents the latest available tabulation of coins offered for sale to the general public through *Coin World* ads.

This tabulation clearly demonstrates just how rare most of the early dates are in mint state grades. In fact, many of the rarities in the series are infrequently available in grades of XF or higher. This gets me to my own interest in the AU grade. In AU condition I found that 15 dates were not offered even once during this five and a half year period and that an additional 36 dates were offered five times or fewer, a frequency of less than once a year. It is no wonder that choice Seated material is in demand.

Table 2 presents a listing of the twenty least available dates in the series, ranked in the order of availability. This list includes 12 San Francisco mint issues, the four early Carson City mint issues, three Philadelphia mint issues and one New Orleans mint issue. All of these dates are difficult to find in mint state condition except for the two Civil War issues from the Philadelphia mint which are very hard to locate in circulated grades. In fact, the 1863 and 1867 dates are the only two in the entire series where 50% or more of the coins offered for sale were in proof condition.

Table 2 also provides a comparison of availability ranking from the two most recent surveys on the Seated dime series. Rarity rankings are included for my top twenty from the 1990 Coin World availability survey by R.E. Jones and the 1990 LSCC member survey. This comparison shows that 13 of the dates in my top 20 were similarly ranked in the Jones survey while 15 of the dates in my top 20 were among the 20 dates least reported in the LSCC survey. All three

surveys had the 1874-CC as the rarest date in the Seated dime series. The 1885-S continues to be the least available San Francisco mint issue and holds down the second spot in terms of availability in Coin World ads. The 1853-O continues to be the least available New Orleans issue through *Coin World* ads even though a relatively large number of examples of this date are in the hands of LSCC members. The 1841 was the only date in my top twenty that was not ranked at least as scarce in either of the two previous surveys. Only one date from the top ten in the Jones survey did not appear in my top twenty. This was the 1876-S which appears to be more available in the current market than it was during the time of the Jones survey in the mid-1980s. Finally, it should be mentioned that the low mintage 1864, 1865 and 1866 dates were among the ten least available dates reported in the LSCC member survey that did not make my list of top twenty dates. This is most likely caused by the number of expensive mint state and proof specimens on the market that can be purchased for a price.
