

Regional News: The LSCC Regional Program is Set to Have an Active Summer Season

Verne reported that the activity at the LSCC and BCCS table was very active during the show. He passed out many LSCC applications to prospective members and exhibited his collection of Mint State Liberty Nickels. Verne reported that most dealers appeared to have strong sales at the show.
